Chairman Hall mentioned an email he received from a Pilot Knob resident complimenting the job the county did paving. He also expressed appreciation to the Department Heads and employees. He congratulated Supervisor Nolan for being appointed to the ACC Board of Trustees, adding he will be replaced on the Community College Committee.
