District Attorney Tony Jordan, Washington County District Attorney's Office is pleased to announce the conviction after trial of Lloyd S. Hall, Sr, for Attempted Kidnapping, Attempted Sexual Abuse in the First Degree and Endangering the Welfare of a Child, with a sentence of up to 15 years in state prison when sentenced on January 6, 2023. The conviction follows an investigation by the Village of Greenwich Police Department and the New York State Police after the defendant handed a young girl a letter when she got off the school bus, enticing her to come to his apartment. Fortunately, this brave little girl and her parents did the right thing. She turned the letter over to her parents and her parents contacted law-enforcement.

What could have been a certain tragedy was thwarted by the brave acts of the young girl, the attentive parents and quick action of law enforcement.
