

**LOCAL LAW 4 FOR THE YEAR, 2006
COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, NEW YORK
Introduced by Supervisor Talkington**

**A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR POWERS OF THE BUDGET OFFICER TO
REVISE, ALTER, OR CHANGE THE REQUESTED ALLOTMENTS IN THE BUDGET OF
THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON PURSUANT TO COUNTY LAW SECTION 375**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Washington as follows:

Section 1: Powers of the Budget Officer

The duly appointed budget officer of the County of Washington is hereby delegated the power and authority on behalf of the Washington County Board of Supervisors to approve, whenever the same may be in his judgment practicable and necessary, the transfer between allotments listed in the budget under a particular object or purpose in an amount not to exceed \$1,000, provided however, that no such allotment or allotments shall be transferred from one department to another without approval by the Board of Supervisors.

Section 2: Filing and Expenditures

A copy of the allotments as finally approved by the budget officer shall be filed with the chief fiscal officer and expenditures shall be made only in accordance with such approved allotments as revised.

Section 3: Severability

The invalidity or invalid application of one provision of this local law shall not affect the validity of any other provision, or any other application of any provision of this local law.

Section 4: Effective Date

This local law shall be effective upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
