A LOCAL LAW Permitting Members of the Community Service Board and its Subcommittees to Serve for More Than Two Terms Consecutively

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Washington as follows:

Section 1: The intent of this local law is to remove the restrictions on the number of consecutive terms of service for members of the Community Service Board or any of its subcommittees.

Section 2: This local law is adopted pursuant to the enabling statute, Section 41.11 (d) of the Mental Hygiene Law, and does hereby authorize and permit members of the Community Service Board, or any of its subcommittees, to serve for more than two terms consecutively.

Section 3: This local law shall be effective and applies to incumbents and all future appointments to the Community Service Board, or its subcommittees, as hereinafter approved.

Section 4: All resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of Washington County, to the extent that the same are inconsistent with this local law, are hereby superceded by this local law.

Section 5: This local law shall take effect immediately after it shall have been adopted and certified copies thereof have been filed as required by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.
